## Paid Healthcare Internships For THS Students

Summer 2021

Program: A paid opportunity to work within and gain exposure to a career in the healthcare industry

Employer: McCullough-Hyde Tri-Health Hospital

When: 8 weeks over June, July, August 2021

Eligibility: High School Juniors and Seniors in the Talawanda School District/Butler Tech with interest in a Healthcare career *including a career that does not require a college degree*

Process: Two students will be chosen based upon review of Application and Interview with Selection Board.

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# Internship Overview

- Successful candidates will become Tri-health employees for 8 weeks.
- Mandatory 2-day employee orientation session on the Monday and Tuesday of first work week.
- The hourly pay will be \$15 per hour, paid bi-weekly subject to appropriate taxes.
- Pay will be paid bi-weekly. (If you start at the beginning of a two week pay period, your pay will be calculated after the completion of the pay period and your check will be issued the Friday after the end of the pay period. Pay periods begin on Sunday and end two weeks later on Saturday night at midnight.
- Interns will be expected to work 8 hours per day, 5-days per week for a total of 40 hours per week.



# Internship Overview

- Currently all hospital employees are required to wear a mask at all times while in the hospital. The assumption is the requirement will still be in place when the interns will be employed this summer.
- Successful Interns will have the opportunity to select either a rotation through hospital departments or a single department placement of specific interest.
- Applications reviewed by April 1. Scoring by section will identify top candidates.
- Interviews scheduled and completed by April 15.
- Final selection by May 1.
