On **Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm**, the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, will be presenting at Sycamore High School about their Connections Dual Admissions (BS/MD) Program. Freshman through juniors who have a strong interest in pursuing a career as a physician, as well as parents are invited to attend.

The Connections Dual Admissions (BS/MD Program) at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine, allows high school seniors to apply and be accepted to both the University of Cincinnati undergraduate college and the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine simultaneously. Connections is a non-accelerated, 8-year BS/MD Program. Admitted students spend four years completing their undergraduate degree at University of Cincinnati followed by four years at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine.

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## Youth Mental Health First Aid Training

Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or is in crisis. Youth Mental Health First Aid is primarily designed for adults who regularly interact with young people. The course introduces common mental health challenges for youth, reviews typical adolescent development, and teaches a 5-step action plan for how to help young people in both crisis and non-crisis situations. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including AD/HD), and eating disorders. Lunch will be provided.
