- **YOU MUST PAY ALL YOUR FEES TO WALK IN GRADUATION AND RECEIVE A DIPLOMA!!**

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

As we continue our drug prevention efforts in the Talawanda School District, we always keep our eyes on the latest trends among youth. The U.S. Surgeon General has recently declared youth use of e-cigarettes an epidemic in this country. As a District we are concerned about the health consequences of this behavior and have partnered with other members of the Butler County Tobacco Policy Coalition to help us understand the issue in more depth.

A survey has been created for youth across Butler County. It will take fewer than 5 minutes to complete and students will complete this survey online during Tutorial. It is completely anonymous. The hope is that these results will give us a clearer picture of how, when, where and with what devices young people are engaged in this behavior so we can better target our education and prevention initiatives.

If you would prefer that your child **not** participate, please inform the Main Office in your building by filling out the form below before **Monday, May 13th**. If we do not receive a form from you, we will assume that your student can participate.

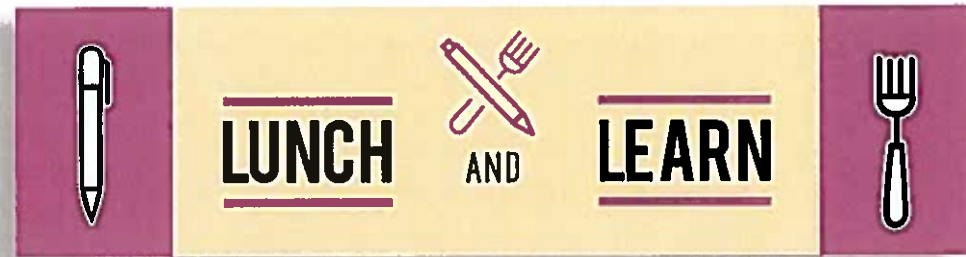
