GUIDELINES FOR RECYCLING AT SCHOOL

- 1) **Recycle Plastic and Glass Bottles, Aluminum Cans, and Paper in recycling containers located in your classroom, hallway and cafeteria.**

Materials you recycle at home are the same ones you can recycle at school. Rumpke provides recycling pick up at each school building.

- 2) **All recyclable materials (aluminum cans/glass/plastic/paper/cardboard) can be placed together in the same recycling container.**

- 3) **Check the recycling POSTERS throughout your school to see what is recyclable.**

- 4) **Not sure what to Recycle??When in doubt - Leave it out!**

If you're really unsure an item can be recycled - ex. Candy Wrapper (not recyclable!) place the material in the trash. Contamination is a big problem with recycling and adding material that doesn't belong with recycling doesn't help get more material recycled....it just slows down the system.
