
Advice for New Students

Bilateral Agreement v CCP

Bilateral Agreement

- Taking UC Classes at THS
- The ACT/Accuplacer is not required to get college credit BUT...
 - The credit is only good at UC
 - C- average must be maintained in each course
 - UC covers the cost of attending these courses.

CCP (College Credit Plus)

- Taking UC Classes at THS
- Qualify for CCP at UC
 - Apply by May 1st
 - ACT or Accuplacer
 - Credit is fully transferable to any college (public v private)
 - No cost for applying/attending

Students who take the required courses and maintain a C- average are AUTOMATICALLY accepted into UC's IT Program!
