Cultural Proficiency Continuum

Cultural Destructiveness: Using one's power to eliminate the culture of another.

Cultural Incapacity: Believing in the superiority of one's own culture and behaving in such a way to disempower another's culture.

Cultural Blindness: Acting as if cultural differences don't matter or as if you don't see them.

Cultural Pre-competence: Awareness of the limitations one's skills or an organization's practices when interacting with other cultural groups.

Cultural Competence: Recognize differences, choose to accept and understand different cultures.

Cultural Proficiency: See the differences, willing to learn and adapt to different cultures.
